DAY 01: HANOI ARRIVAL

Arrive at Noi Bai International Airport, welcome by our guide and transfer to your hotel. The transfer distance is approximately 40 munities.

Hanoi or "River-bound City" as its name literally means is Vietnam's capital with a thousand-year-old history dating back to 1010. The city's fascinating beauty which is characterized by unique cultural relics, ancient streets of antique houses, elegant French colonial buildings, tree-lined boulevards and romantic lakes has made it one of the most charming cities of Asia.



Overnight stay in Hanoi.

DAY 02: HANOI FULL DAY CITY TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed for a full day sightseeing tour of Hanoi.

The tour starts with a visit to Ho Chi Minh Complex which features the life of Ho Chi Minh, the nation's founder. At the complex, visit the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum, the colonial Presidential Palace, the One Pillar Pagoda. Continue to the Temple of Literature, known as the first university of Vietnam built in 1070 by the Ly Dynasty to honor Confucius, sages and outstanding Vietnamese scholars.



In the afternoon, continue the tour to one of the following museums of choice namely: the Museum of Fine Arts, the National Museum of Vietnamese History, the Museum of Revolution, the Museum of Military History or the Museum of Ethnology.





Late afternoon, visit Hoan Kiem Lake and Ngoc Son Temple located on an islet in the lake. Hoan Kiem Lake is the center point of Hanoi and home to a rare endangered giant turtle species. Its name "Returned Sword" comes from a legend of a sacred sword being lent to an ancient Vietnamese King by a holy turtle from the lake and later returned to the turtle.

DAY 03: HA LONG BAY CRUISE

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Ha Long Bay, which is about 160 km or 3.5-hour drive away. On the way, you will see some rural areas of the Red River Delta with plenty of chances to take photos of Vietnamese farmers working in paddy fields. Stop half way to visit a handicraft workshop of fine clothes and embroidered paintings.

Upon arrival in Ha Long City, aboard your cruise ship and proceed for check-in. Start cruising while having lunch on board and enjoy the mighty bay view.



Ha Long Bay meaning Descending Dragon Bay in Vietnamese as legend has it that it was where a holly dragon landed down from sky. The bay, famous as one of the world's wonders and heritage sites whose formation dates back 500 million years, consists of around 2,000 karst islands and islets scattered over an area of 1,553 km2. The bay cruise will continue with up close sighting of Dinh Huong Island, Ga Choi Island, Dog Island, Sail Island, a visit to Sung Sot Cave and swimming stop at Titov Beach. Relax to enjoy the bay view at sunset, have dinner after, go fishing and spend a night on board.



DAY 04: DEBOARD CRUISE AND TRANSFER TO PHU QUOC BY FLIGHT

After breakfast onboard the cruise, visit Human head shaped island and Tortoise Island. Continue to cruise into Bai Tu Long Bay to discover the adjacent bay of "The Little Dragon Bowing to His Mother" as it is named.

Check out and have lunch on board while heading to shore. Disembark and transfer back to Hanoi airport for flight to Phu Quoc. Upon arrival in Phu Quoc, you will be transferred to hotel for check in.





Phú Quốc is a Vietnamese island off the coast of Cambodia in the Gulf of Thailand. It's known for white-sand beaches and resorts, most of which are along the palm-lined southwest coast. More than half of the island is part of Phú Quốc National Park, which features mountains, dense tropical jungle, hiking trails and wildlife. Duong Dong is the largest town, with day and night markets selling crafts, produce and fish., Phu Quoc's 150-kilometer coastline, with gentle waves and transparent turquoise water, makes it Vietnam's most popular destination for water sports.

DAY 05 : DAY AT LEISURE IN PHU QUOC ISLAND

After breakfast at the hotel, rest of the day has been kept free for your leisure.

With 150 kilometers of coastline, you can spend every day in Phu Quoc on a different beach. Head east for postcard-pretty Bai Sao to try your hand at water sports like windsurfing or jet skiing. Head west for the cafes, clubs, and sunsets of Long Beach. To the north, there's silent Ganh Dau, given privacy by a jungle-covered mountain ridge. The best southern beaches are scattered across the 22-island archipelago and can be reached by boat.

Visit the prison to learn about the savage punishments and tortures faced by the war prisoners in Phu Quoc prison.

DAY 06 : DAY AT LEISURE IN PHU QUOC ISLAND

After breakfast at the hotel, rest of the day is free for you to explore Phu Quoc on your own.

You can spend the day enjoying at Phu Quoc's world famous theme parks :

1. VinWonders Phu Quoc is listed among the largest theme parks in Vietnam. Coming there, tourists of all ages and personalities can find their ideal destinations to explore. The exciting activities and the colorful life of thousands of sea creatures here will bring you an unprecedented entertaining experience in your Phu Quoc trip. In VinWonders Phu Quoc, you can find 6 subdivisions inspired by the 12 worldwide civilizations. : European Streetmosphere , Typhoon World, Mysterious Viking Village, Fairy World, Adventure World, Neptune Palace



2. The new Aquatopia water park was launched in December 2019. Located in the Sun World Hon Thom Natural Park, you need to take the world's longest cable 15-kilometer cable car just to reach the park. The zoological park is the largest in the country, doing important conservation work to protect hundreds of plant and animal species, including rare and endangered ones. The waterpark has 21 thrilling games from the world's leading manufacturers, suitable for people of all ages for a day of unforgettable fun at Phu Quoc.

DAY 07: TRANSFER TO HO CHI MINH CITY BY FLIGHT

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to Phu Quoc airport to cach your flight to Ho Chi Minh. Upon arrival in Ho Chi Minh city, you will be welcomed by our guide and transfered to hotel for check in.

Ho Chi Minh City formerly named Saigon is the largest city and economic center of Vietnam always bustled with activities of modern life. It is where businesses converge and shoppers indulge themselves into unlimited choices. However the city also carries with it a rich historical legacy in contrast with its dazzling glamor.

DAY 08: SAIGON SIGHTSEEING TOUR WITH CU CHI TUNNEL

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed for a full-day sightseeing tour of Ho Chi Minh City.

We shall start the tour with visit to the Cu Chi Tunnels, a major underground hideout and resistance base of Viet Cong forces during the two wars against the French and later on Americans. The tunnels are entirely hand-dug, formed a highly intricate network of interlinked multilevel passageways at times stretched as far as the Cambodian border and totaling over 120 km in length. Its complexity was beyond imagination containing meeting rooms, kitchens, wells, clinics, schools, depots, trenches and emergency exits all aimed for guerrilla warfare.





After the tunnel tour, we shall visit the Saigon Notre-Dame Basilica, a neo-Roman cathedral built by the colonial French with materials entirely imported from Marseilles. We shall also visit the Saigon Central Post Office, which was designed and constructed in the early 20th Century by the famous French architect Gustave Eiffel. Then, visit the War Remnants Museum, which features an extensive collection of exhibits including weaponry, photos and documentation on Vietnam's wars with the French and Americans. End of day, you have free time to go shopping at Ben Thanh Market

DAY 09: FULL DAY MEKONG DELTA TOUR FROM SAIGON

After breakfast at the hotel, travel by road to the Mekong Delta, the world's largest delta and Vietnam's largest rice bowl.



Upon arrival in My Tho City, capital of Tieng Giang Provine, embark on a boat and navigate through intricate canals while observing the local daily life up close as well as the landscape of waterways and lush islands. Land on the Unicorn Island to enjoy wandering through verdant orchards, tasting fresh fruits and listening to some Southern style traditional music. Move on to the second delta province, Ben Tre, where you will watch local villagers make coconut candy in a rural workshop, walk around briefly and try riding a horse-pulled carriage. More cruising to some bee-keeping households to taste fresh homegrown honey and honey tea.
