DAY 01: ARRIVAL AT REYKJAVIK AIRPORT

On arrival at Reykjavik Airport in Iceland, you will be met by our local representative in Ireland for a brief meet and greet. You will then proceed to a hotel & check in.

Reykjavik, on the coast of Iceland, is the country's capital and largest city. It's home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history. The striking concrete Hallgrimskirkja church and rotating Perlan glass dome offer sweeping views of the sea and nearby hills.

DAY 02: REYKJAVIK HOP-ON HOP-OFF CITY TOUR

After breakfast at the hotel, enjoy a day of exploration in Reykjavík at your own pace with the Hop-On Hop-Off City Sightseeing Bus. This iconic red double-decker bus offers a convenient way to discover the city's most famous landmarks, with 16 stops strategically located near key attractions. The journey begins at Harpa Concert Hall & Conference Centre, an architectural masterpiece that serves as a cultural hub. As the bus moves toward the Old Harbour, visitors can take in the colourful buildings that line the waterfront, each carrying a unique charm. This area also presents an opportunity for an exciting whalewatching tour, where one can witness Iceland's diverse marine life.



For those interested in history and archaeology, Reykjavík City Museum offers a fascinating multi-media experience centered on the excavation of a Viking longhouse dating back to the 10th century. Another must-visit stop is Laekjargata Street, home to some of the oldest houses in Iceland, reflecting the city's rich heritage. Perlan, another significant landmark, boasts a panoramic viewing deck that offers breathtaking views of the city and beyond. The tour also takes visitors to Laugardalur Valley, also known as Hot Spring Valley, where one can relax in the geothermal outdoor pools, a popular activity regardless of the season. Nearby, the Reykjavík Zoo provides a delightful experience, particularly for families.











SEGV'S RECOMEDATION For those seeking an extraordinary adventure, an optional whale-watching tour is available. Setting sail from Faxaflói Bay, this tour offers a chance to observe Iceland's marine giants, including minke whales, humpback whales, white-beaked dolphins, and harbor porpoises. The journey is enhanced by expert guides who provide insights into the region's diverse marine life. While common species are frequently spotted, lucky visitors may even catch a glimpse of rare whales such as killer whales, fin whales, or long-finned pilot whales. The tour provides a remarkable contrast between the vast ocean and Iceland's rugged landscapes, making it an unforgettable experience. After a day of exploration and adventure, return to the hotel.

DAY 03: VISIT TO GOLDEN CIRCLE

After breakfast, we will proceed to visit the Golden Circle in Southern Iceland. The Golden Circle is one of the most famous of all scenic routes in Iceland and combines stunning landmarks and historically significant places in a circular sightseeing tour.

The three primary stops on the route are the Thingvellir National Park, the Gullfoss waterfall, and the geothermal area in Haukadalur, which contains the geysers Geysir and Strokkur. Though Geysir has been mostly dormant for many years, Strokkur continues to erupt every 5–10 minutes. Other stops include the Kerid volcanic crater, the town of Hveragerdi, Skálholt cathedral, and the Nesjavellir and Hellisheidarvirkjun geothermal power plants.
